PHASE TWO OF THE PARISH DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY LAUNCHES IN SEFTON

The second phase of the Parish Development Strategy was officially launched, as steering groups came together for a creative and forward-looking workshop. **WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?** In the coming weeks, each Deanery will receive its own realistic data and future projections. They will engage deeply with the Pastoral Plan and develop proposals for their Deanery that are both missionary in focus and sustainable in practice. This strategy is being rolled out across the Archdiocese, with South Liverpool and Warrington & Widnes the next Deaneries to begin the process. The hope is that within two years, every Deanery will have embarked on this journey - helping us all become the Church God is calling us to be, both now and in the near future.
